



## Inspiring Minds Building Campaign FAQs

### **What is the goal of the campaign?**

\$1.5 million dollars

### **What is the purpose of this campaign?**

To create a permanent space for youth to have after-school and summer programming that will enrich their lives, and to be able to serve more students.

### **Can I pledge over time?**

Yes, pledge commitments can be made for up to five years.

### **Why does IM need this building?**

This building is needed to provide a safe, secure setting for our students and give IM room to grow.

### **How does IM impact the community?**

IM serves 300+ Warren students (and their families) annually, compliments the work of Warren City Schools, collaborates with partner organizations, generates volunteerism among community members, and employs approximately 40 young staff members each year.

### **Who oversees IM operations?**

IM is governed by a 7-member volunteer board of directors representing church, business, and community leaders.

### **What is Inspiring Minds annual operating budget?**

In 2017, IM's annual operating budget was \$1,045,575.

### **How are IM staff and volunteers involved in the community?**

IM was chosen to lead the We Are Warren youth initiative. IM staff and volunteers often speak to youth in the community, and provide support to families in need. IM students participate in beautification projects and clean ups, and take pride in their community.

### **How will my gift make a difference?**

Your generosity will allow IM to raise the bar in youth enrichment programming, serve more students, beautify the community, and ensure that youth will always have a safe place to call home.

### **How will my funds be used?**

Funds received will be put toward the costs associated with completely renovating the building in this three-phase process.

### **Is my gift tax deductible?**
